Impressions "I will come again and receive you to Myself, that where I am, there you may be also"

"appear a second time *for salvation*" = for deliverance - from death and sin / not to sleep - not to wait - but to be with Him in many rooms/places. If we didn't pass through unto continued life then death would have held us and it can't hold us because Christ has the right to redeem us - and will do as He has promised.

This is in effect our personal judgement (die then judgement - everyone). If we know Christ and eagerly seek Him, He will come to deliver us from death. In the absence of looking to Christ, there is no deliverance from death.

We may think of judgement being a determination/judgement made by one person about another, but this judgement is simply a result of our having or not having faith in God our Father and Christ His blessed Son!
